


## **FOUR SEASONS LANDAA GIRAAVARU PREMIERES WORLD-EXCLUSIVE DEEPFLIGHT ADVENTURES**

*Explore UNESCO Waters in DeepFlight's First 3-Person Super Falcon 3S:  
The Pinnacle of Personal Submarine Technology*



**Landaa Giraavaru, Maldives, May XXX, 2018** – DeepFlight produces the world's highest performance personal submarines. On May XXX, 2018, Four Seasons Resort Maldives at Landaa Giraavaru will become the first place to launch submarine excursions in DeepFlight's most advanced model yet: the Super Falcon 3S.

In a world exclusive, DeepFlight Adventures take up to two guests on a once-in-a-lifetime sub-aquatic 'dive' exploration of the Maldives' only UNESCO Biosphere Reserve, Landaa Giraavaru's Baa Atoll home.

With a professional pilot at the controls, passengers can skim over coral formations; fly through shoals of brightly coloured fish; encounter creatures like turtles, sharks, dolphins and rays; and explore the Maldivian waters down to a depth of 37 metres/120 feet – all without getting wet.

Brought to the Maldives in collaboration with leading water sports operator, Ocean Group Pvt. Ltd, the Super Falcon 3S represents the pinnacle of personal submarine technology: an environmentally friendly, battery-operated submersible that offers unparalleled underwater 'flying' from the safety, comfort and style of a personal pressurised and air-conditioned cockpit, with individual viewing domes.

Once submerged, the domes virtually disappear, providing a 360-degree view of the underwater world. Additionally, its flight-inspired design allows the Super Falcon 3S to glide effortlessly over reefs and cruise alongside marine mammals like dolphins.

The Super Falcon 3S has also been designed with the environment in mind: its electric and acoustic emissions have been minimised so as not to disturb marine life; it never lands on the seabed or reefs; it is constantly tracked/monitored by a surface team; and its communication system enables pilots to educate and inspire guests with a real-time commentary of the underwater ecosystem.

Safety is DeepFlight's number one priority. Certified by Lloyds Register, a leading marine certification organisation, the Super Falcon 3S features fixed positive buoyancy and a patented thrust and lift system that enables it to not only 'fly' underwater, but to automatically float back to the surface in the unlikely event of power loss.

Commenting on the launch, Regional Vice President Armando Kraenzlin said, "At Four Seasons Landaa Giraavaru, we have long been aligned with DeepFlight's mission to bring awareness to the oceans. These submarine excursions redefine marine exploration and bridge the gap between the world we see above the waves and the one that exists below. We couldn't be prouder to be the first resort in the world to launch the DeepFlight Super Falcon 3S."

**How long is a DeepFlight Adventures' submarine excursion?**

*About 1 hour from boarding to flying underwater and disembarkation.*

**What are the age/weight/height restrictions?**

*Children must be aged 7 and above and over 1.2-metres tall; maximum weight per person is 120 kg (265 lbs); maximum height is 1.9 metres (6.4 ft.).*

**How much does a DeepFlight Adventures' excursion cost at Four Seasons Landaa Giraavaru?**

*US\$1500.00 (+ 12% GST) per flight for up to a maximum of two passengers.*
